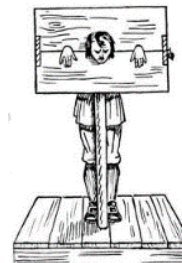




Summer Term 2018 - Team Amethyst

Crime and Punishment



History
