Dear Parent/ Carers,

I would like to say thank you everyone, pupils, parents, grandparents, staff for making it into school yesterday, and to Mr Lewis for making sure school was open.

We welcome Mrs Telfer to Reception and Nursery and Mrs Calvert to Year 3/4 this term. Both have settled in really well and are getting to know your children. We also have a Baby and Toddler Group on a Thursday morning 9:30am - 11:15am. Come along and meet Mrs Telfer.

I would like to take this opportunity to let you know that from September, we will be taking in two year olds. We will only be taking in a small number so it will be first come who gets the places. Sessions will run at £5.50 per hour or you may be entitled to 15 hours free. Contact school for more information.

You must have noticed me monitoring parking outside school, with the support of the community police. I would like to remind you it is against the law to park on the yellow lines.
