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Dear Parent/Carers,

Can I take this opportunity to say thank you for all your support over the year in raising money for the Alzheimer's Society. With all the events that have taken place in school and mine and Paul's climb of Ben Nevis last weekend (during the night) we have raised about £1000. There was also another three climbs taking place and between us all we raised £176K which will provide 5 dementia carers for families for a year. Again, thank you so much.

Sport's day was a great success too with the children really enjoying the different activities they took part in. It was lovely seeing you all there, and especially all the parents who took part in the races. Thank you to the FoFS for their support and time serving teas and the raffle etc.

The 'Fiver Challenge' that took part in June was massively supported by you all again. The children were given £5.00 and they had to make money out of it. They then gave back £5.50 but their profit was fed back into the school and its Enterprise scheme. This scheme allows children to develop a greater understanding of the environment, starting at home with their family then ending with a view of The World. Children develop a much better understanding of their community and the cause and effect of changes.

Next week we have our trip to Saltburn on Tuesday. Children going with parents will be given £2.00 for their lunch before they leave. All other children have ordered their lunches. If the weather turns bad, we will return to school early so keep an eye on your text messages, if it is forecast bad weather. Please ensure all children are in school to be registered even if travelling with parents. Can everyone be at school for 8:45 and we should return between 4:00 and 4:30. Dress for the weather and provide sickness tablets, sun hats and cream.

Leavers' service takes place on Thursday at 1:15. This year DVDs have been recorded of our year 6 children, and I have to say they are very good. They will be sold for £7.50 each. I would just like to say thank you to Jenny Collinwood for organising this, and her and Helen Crowther's support with the enterprises scheme.

Our last day of term is Thursday 16th July for children, although staff will be in school training on Friday 17th. We return to school on Tuesday 1st September, again for training. Children return on Thursday 3rd September. Can you please call into school and collect lost property on Monday 13th July at 3:30pm.

There will be a meeting for parents and children going to London on Thursday 3rd September at 3:30pm in Team 3.

In September, Miss Ingram will be joining us in Team 1 and we will have a new deputy head teacher, Mr Soulsby in Team 3 when Miss Herriot goes on maternity leave. The children did get to interview him on Thursday and really liked him, I think they are looking forward to him starting, particularly as he plays the guitar in assembly. Team 2 will be taught by Mrs Calvert and EYFS by Mrs Telfer and Miss Race, who will be with our two year olds. A new challenge for our school taking in two year olds. They did really enjoy their taster days. Miss Hemmingway will cover PPA in classes.

After school clubs will continue to take place in the autumn term £1.50 for the first hour and £3.00 for the second. Club information will follow.

Dinner money is £1.95 for Key Stage 2, Key Stage 1 is free and Nursery is £2.35.

Breakfast club starts at 8:00am and costs £2:00 per day.

Only nursery children's parents should be walking down to nursery. Reception children will line up in the yard, I know this may take a little getting used to, but they will. All other children need to use the children's entrance.

Swimming will be on a Tuesday morning starting with Team 3. PE days will be given out at the start of the Autumn term once you receive timetables.
