They are being forceful and threatening saying that they owe money from unpaid taxes and if they don't pay it then they will turn up at their house, remove their belongings and money and cut off their bank accounts and any benefits. At least one elderly gentleman has paid nearly £3000 and an elderly female went to the bank to pay nearly £5000 but was stopped by bank staff. This is a scam, if you receive a similar call you should not, under any circumstances, pay any money and should contact the police on telephone number 101.
