Neighbourhood Watch News

FAMILIES across the region are being invited to celebrate the work of local superheroes, at a free family fun day which is back for its third year.

Following the success of previous events, visitors this year can get involved in demonstrations and activities from familiar faces such as the County Durham & Darlington Fire and Rescue Service, RNLI, the Police (including the Interceptors), other emergency services and local community organisations.

There are numerous competitions children can get involved in, including a treasure hunt, and the Halloween or Superhero fancy dress competition is always very popular. This year's event will also be autism-friendly until 12pm.

Bonfire Night – we have had reminders from Neighbourhood Watch about staying safe on Bonfire Night.

- An organised display is the safest way to enjoy fireworks.
- Fireworks are noisy (which can upset very young or elderly people as well as pets) they can cause damage and they can cause serious injuries if not used properly.
- You have to be 16 or over to buy 'novelty' fireworks, such as sparklers, caps and 'serpents', and 18 or over to buy all other types of fireworks.
- It is an offence to let fireworks off between 11pm and 7am except on 5th November, Diwali, New Year's Eve and Chinese New Year when the curfew is 1am. It is also an offence to set off fireworks in a public place.
