### Mary Anning

What can you find out about the great fossil hunter Mary Anning? You could also have a go at finding any fossils of your own or making some.



### Local Bedrock

Can you find out what the local bedrock is either by researching online, in books or go and see what type of rocks you can see around - what have old buildings been made from?



### Spelling Shed

Log into Spelling Shed and play games to help you practise your spellings each week. Your user name and password are your first and last name with no spaces - remember capital letters!



### Help the Environment

Design a poster to help remind everyone of ways they can help the environment. This could be done with art materials or on a computer.



### Nature Poem

Write a poem about one of your favourite outside places. It could be a garden, park, tree or flower. You can choose the style of your poem - a good way to start is to start listing features of your inspiration.



### Future

What would you like the world to be like in the future? Think about what you would like it to look like, what you would like the climate to be like?



### Would I Lie to You

Make up two lies and one thing that is true about yourself. Can you convince us to believe a lie or will we spot the truth?

Bring cooking and your knowledge of rocks together by making cinder toffee that bubbles up like lava from a real volcano before cooling to make hard rock! You could also make rock cakes that look strangely like real rocks and are changed by the heat of the oven rather like metamorphic rocks are changed by the heat of the Earth! Sedimentary Sandwiches are made of many different layers just like sedimentary rock. Remember to take photos, draw pictures or write a recipe of anything you make.
