<p align="center"><i>Week Beginning 04/10/21</i> Words with ending '-ture' Examples: creature, furniture, picture, nature, adventure, capture, future, sculpture, fracture, mixture, culture, moisture, gesture, structure, lecture, literature, miniature, signature, temperature, texture, departure, puncture</p>	<p align="center"><i>Week Beginning 11/10/21</i> Challenge Words Examples: actual, answer, circle, earth, fruit, island, often, popular, skipped, who, write, should, picture, January, Wednesday, address, appear, arrive, believe, build, busy, business, calendar</p>

<p align="center"><i>Week Beginning 22/11/21</i> Adding suffixes Examples: gardening, gardened, limited, limiting, developing, developed, listening, listened, covered, covering, offering, offered, benefited, benefiting, focused, focusing</p>	<p align="center"><i>Week Beginning 29/11/21</i> Adding suffixes doubling final consonant Examples: forgetting, forgotten, beginning, preferred, permitted, regretting, committed, forbidden, propelled, equipped, occurred, occurring, committed</p>
