



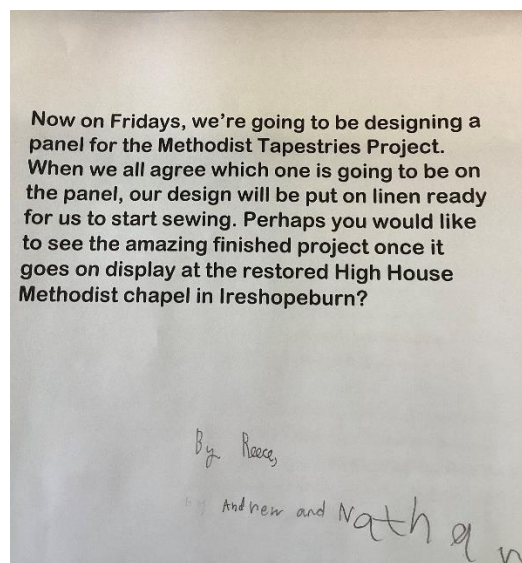

Replacement Boiler

We are pleased to say that work will start on replacing our boilers on Monday. There will be some disruption while this takes place.

A team will start stripping out the old boiler from Monday; they will be on site between 8 - 4.30 each day.

They will fence off an area around the boiler house steps, approximately 3m out from the wall and 6m wide. We will still be able to access school through the playground and have playtimes but we will make sure that the children are aware that they need to stay away from the fences.

We have advised the team that no vehicles should access or leave the premises between 8.45 and 9.15 and between 3.15 and 3.30.
