#### **Staffing**

#### **School Uniform**

In the new academic year starting 7<sup>th</sup> September 2022, please ensure that your child brings their PE kit into school, this will be kept in school for the term. A PE kit should consist of a white t-shirt, navy jogging bottoms, shorts or navy leggings. A school jumper or a hoody of your choice can also be provided. Please note that if you have ordered already a PE t-shirt this can be used for the next year.

Full school uniform should be worn every day. This should consist of a white polo shirt or shirt, a red jumper or cardigan with grey or black trousers, skirt, shorts or pinafore dress. In summer, children may wear a red or light blue summer dress. Appropriate footwear should also be worn, this should be black shoes. Trainers should be used during PE lessons only.
